

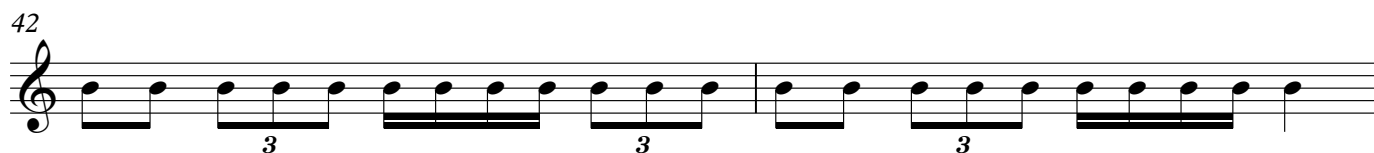
Reading Rhythm Exercises

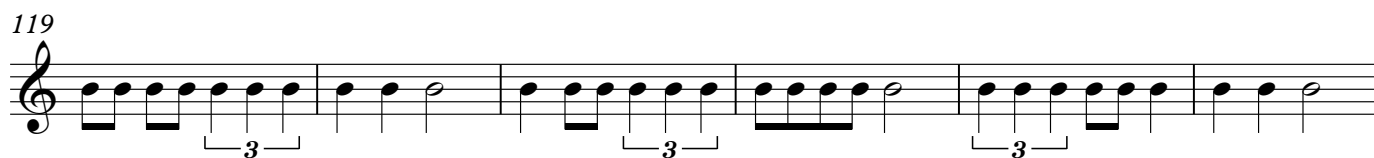
